HIV/AIDS Program Makes Eternal Difference

As we close out 2012, how fitting that we partnered once again with Reach the People Ministries in Ghana, Africa. Having worked side by side with Eugene, Gabriel, William, and Solomon on several projects in past days, it was our privilege and joy to sponsor this project in Duayaw Nkwanta in the Brong Ahafo region in Northern Ghana. Thank you to those of you who prayed for this last project of the year and to those who continue to faithfully support God's Ministry through Evangelism Partners and those ministries with whom we partner. Heaven only knows the full IMPACT that your investment in the KINGDOM OF GOD has made. The Gospel was preached in 4 Training Seminars, 11 Film Crusades, and 24 School assemblies to a total of 8,832 people with 3,949 indicating a decision to receive Jesus Christ. The following testimonies were sent to us from Eugene Narh:

Santase is one of the remote villages under Duayaw Nkwanta near Sunyani. This was the first time a movie was shown at Santase. There is no electricity in that community so our power generator helped in illuminating the village. Almost everybody in the village came out to the crusading ground. Our film crusade was very successful and it attracted most people from the surrounding hamlets who walked for about one and a half hours to attend our film crusade, some repented and gave their lives to Christ. All celebrated the successful program we had while the transformation that took place in the village encouraged our team. Some of our counselors who came to help in recording the names of the new converts danced and praised the Lord for the positive impact of the program.

Michael, a teacher in the Catholic Junior High School said, he was highly impressed and blessed by the talk on HIV/AIDS menace supported by the Salvation message. He said the uniqueness of the program had a positive impact on the entire school. Some students and teachers gave their lives to Christ as RPM tackled part of the problems the students encounter and suggested solutions for them. He said he was really happy because it was an answer to a prayer. He went on to say that the talk was so rich that it answered some of the problems in their school and that he was grateful for the transformation that had taken place as a result.
