We had four (4) days outreach program in the first town in the EAST and this town is called CHONGWE. We had an outreach of 17 Basic Schools and one (1) Youth Training Skills Center. And further had the Jesus Film Show everyday, from Tuesday to date. We did two film show meetings at Chongwe open ground, then we were requested to show it at the Refunsa Bus Stop on Thursday. The area has several challenges, one is beer drinking , high levels of prostitution, witchcraft, un-religious people, and further more, the churches found in this area lack leadership qualities, hence, SOME PASTORS WANT ME TO COME BACK AND HELP TEACH LEADERSHIP TO THE PASTORS FELLOWSHIP IN

THE AREA. They appreciated the Jesus Film Show and requested that we stay one more time. Friday we showed it at the Youth Skills Training Center, the area surrounded by 13 Villages and everybody came out to watch the Jesus Film Show, even though it was raining. We could not imagine how people could be dedicated to this. We thought they would leave and go, and PATSON wanted to switch off the projector, but we heard from Villagers and youths



SAYING: NO DON'T SWITH OFF, we shall stand even if the rain soaks us, we have come from far places to watch this video film. So go ahead sir, so that

WHY SHOULD THEY PERISH WHEN WE ARE THERE?

The International Mission Board (IMB) has defined an UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUP as a distinct people group that has less than 2% of its population with a strategic witness for Christ. The IMB has defined an UNENGAGED People Group as a distinct people group that has NO Christian Witness or Evangelical Church. God has placed a MANDATE on the ministry of EPI to begin reaching the UUPG'S of Zambia, most of which are located in the Eastern Region of Zambia. God has also put this MANDATE upon the heart of Pastor Enock Enjovu. Please hear his following email:

Just this morning of my time, I called a meeting with my fellow three Pastors for a discussion plan of our June 2012 project, on how we shall do school ministry and the showing of the Jesus Film Show in the Eastern Region of Zambia. All my 3 colleagues agree that we truly need to focus on the EAST, for it has a larger population, and have not much evangelical witness. There are also distant towns and villages, that you cannot visit without having a motor vehicle of your own. There is great work to be achieved here and many souls are perishing without hearing Jesus and repenting to come to the Lord. Your consideration to help raise funds towards purchase of a VAN will be very much appreciated for it will enable us reach the unreached people with the GOSPEL. People in the East are buried with a lot of

tradition and they in most times act themselves contrary to Bible teachings, and need someone to PREACH to them. Kindly come to our aid, and help us reach these people. We must begin soon proclaiming the Gospel in this area, **AND WHY SHOULD THESE PEOPLE PERISH WHEN WE ARE THERE?**

Zambian Certificate Approved

God has been moving to position EPI to be a recognized ministry in Zambia. To work legally within Zambia one must have a certificate from the government to be official. Generally the process takes up to 90 days. Sometimes the government rejects the application entirely. God in His Sovereignty chose to turn the kings heart (Prov. 21:1). Enock Enjovu submitted EPI's application February 27 and received approval February 28. This is very good news for EPI. No longer will we operate under the certificate of one of our partnering ministries. Now we can move forward in ministry under the registration of Evangelism Partners Ministries International.
